Dean's Update

- The Library officially launched an outdoor [locker pickup service](#). This is a contact-free service to retrieve books and media between the hours of 6:00 a.m. - 10:00 p.m., seven days a week. Tremendous positive response has been shared by students and faculty.
- The Library is working with Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) and Campus Operations for a target reopening date in late March or early April. The reopening will be in a limited capacity by reservation only, specifically for individual study/workstations. A wider reopening is planned for the fall 2021 at 25% capacity.

Q & A:

- Q. Will the Creative Media Studio open this spring? A. No, but it will open in the fall if approved through EHS and in compliance with L.A. County guidelines.
- Q. Are TCC items included in the books by mail service? A. Limited items are available.
- Q. What is the status of Interlibrary and CSU+ loans? A. Both electronic and physical materials can be requested via Interlibrary Loan and CSU+ through the Library website for pickup by locker or by mail. Mail service will probably phase out sometime during the summer.
