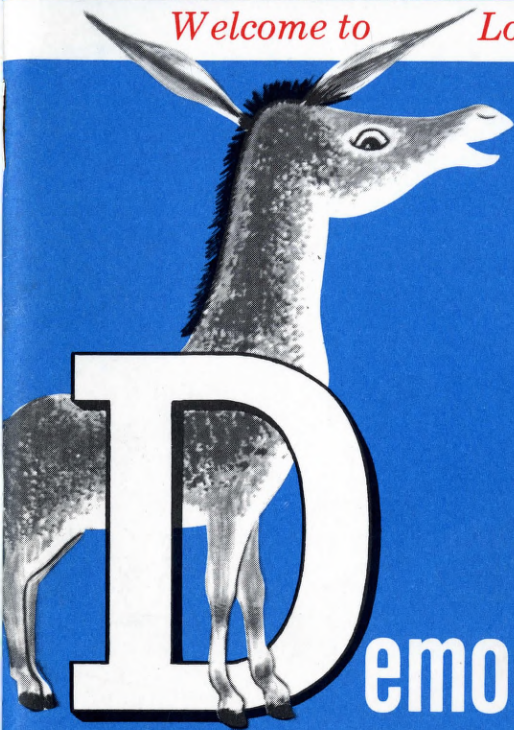

Telephone Information

PHONE NUMBERS

The special telephone number for the Democratic National Committee is MADison 5-3500. Call this number, *NOT* the number of the Biltmore Hotel, for information about official convention business.

Look in the Central Telephone Directory for other numbers. Those not found there may be obtained by dialing 1-1-3 for "Information."

CALLING NEARBY POINTS

From Los Angeles calls to certain nearby cities can be made by merely giving the number to the local operator. Just deposit a dime or two nickels, wait for the dial tone and dial "0". The operator will place your call.

CALLING LONG DISTANCE

If you have the proper amount of change it will probably save you time, or you may use your Telephone Credit Card. For Long Distance calls follow the same steps as above except dial 1-1-0 to reach the operator. You'll find it's faster.

DIRECT DISTANCE DIALING

When calling Long Distance from a telephone that has access to Direct Distance Dialing, you must first dial the three-digit Area Code of the city you wish to call, then dial the telephone number just as you do on a local call. To obtain Area Codes please refer to the list in your directory. (*Los Angeles Area Code 213.*)

TELEPHONE DIRECTORY

A Telephone Directory Library is available for your use at our main office at 740 South Olive Street.

TELEGRAMS

To send a telegram, cablegram or radiogram from Pay Phones, after depositing your coin—Dial the “0” operator and ask for Western Union.

CORRECT TIME

To get the correct time...dial ULrich 3-1212.

HOW TO MAKE AN EMERGENCY CALL

DIAL 116 OR CALL OPERATOR

and say . . . *I want to report a FIRE*

I want a POLICEMAN

I want an AMBULANCE

I want the SHERIFF

Tell the operator your TELEPHONE NUMBER, the ADDRESS and CITY where the emergency exists. An attempt will be made to connect you with the required number.

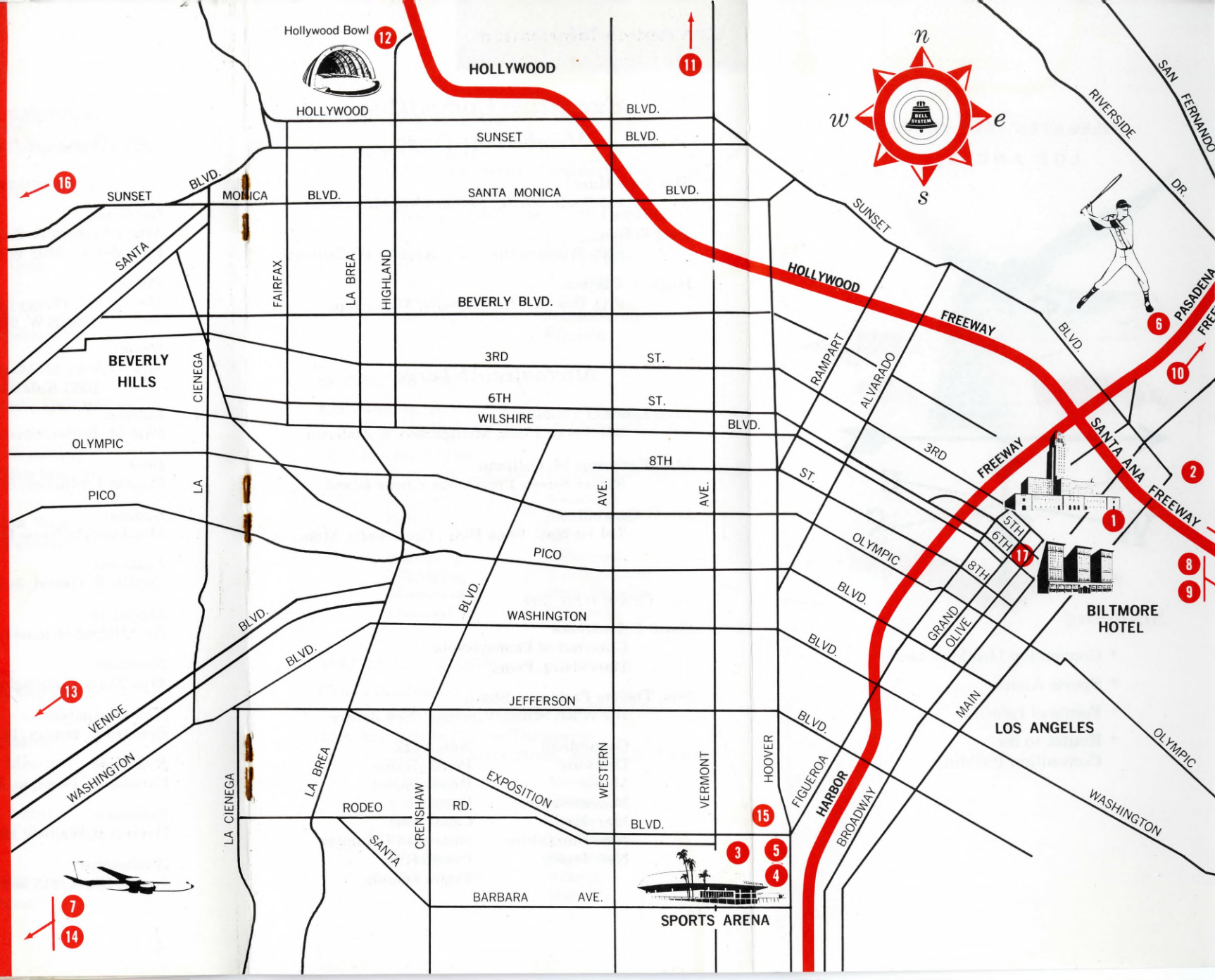

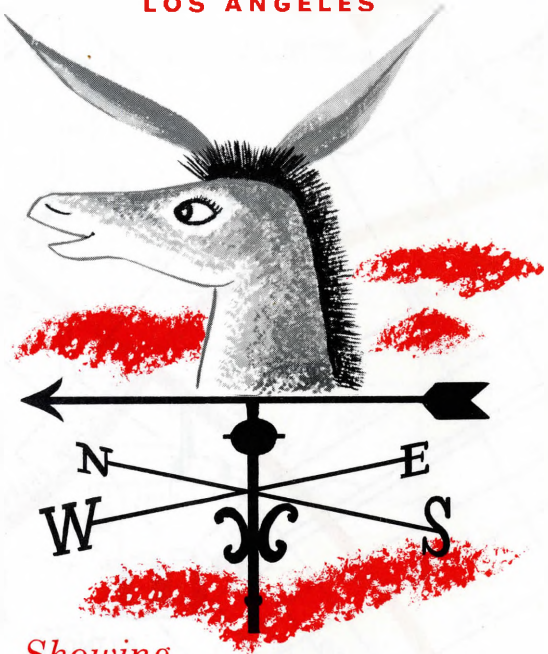
